I am requesting funding for 26 Monroe Street in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Norwalk Housing Authority, located at 24 ½ Monroe Street, Norwalk 06854.

The funding would be used for the redevelopment of a public housing site adjacent to the South Norwalk Metro-North train station into a mixed-income residential community of up to 100 units serving low- and moderate-income households. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will expand affordable housing, advance transit-oriented development, and ensure that South Norwalk's growth remains inclusive to diverse households earning low-to-moderate incomes. The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(4).
