I am requesting funding for the Lockwood & Heather Lane Drainage Improvements in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Norwalk, located at 125 East Avenue, Norwalk, Connecticut 06851.

The funding would be used for the separation of the known combined sanitary and storm system and drainage improvements.
