
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the MLK Corridor Equitable Mobility Enhancements in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Norwalk Redevelopment Agency, located at 3 Belden Avenue, Norwalk, Connecticut 06850.

The funding would be used to improve transportation and mobility around the South Norwalk Train Station. The funding will go toward undergrounding utilities, roadway milling and paving, sidewalk reconstruction, installation of pedestrian lighting, and painted traffic markings for bike lanes and crosswalks. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will increase safety and access in a federally-designated Historically Disadvantaged Community. Improving transportation around the MLK Corridor will better connect residents to employment, increase business opportunities, and encourage continued transit-oriented development in the area.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by chapter 53 of title 49 of the United States Code. I certify that I have no financial interest in this project, and neither does anyone in my immediate family.
